Rotary International is largely responsible for the eradication of polio throughout the world.



We pitch in and support local programs.

Maybe you've seen our Chuckwagon team serving food favorites at Oz-Stravaganza and other events, or met our tool-bearing crews at work on a volunteer project, or attended a Rotary fundraiser such as Lobsterfest or Casino Night. We're out there, and we take intentional action.

We support: Chittenango High School scholarships * Bear Country Little League * Dollars for Scholars * Summer concerts * Sullivan Park pavilions * Adopt-a-Highway Program * Chittenango Landing Canal Boat Museum * CNY Lyme Support * Toys for Tots * Boy Scouts * Chittenango Oz-Stravaganza and Oz Museum * Chittenango & Bridgeport Food Cupboards * Du'Nango Duathlon for the CNY Susan G.
